6. One bloom, LARGE CUP, (DIV 2) WHITE PERIANTH.
7. Three blooms, LARGE CUP, (DIV 2).
8. One bloom, SMALL CUP, (DIV 3) YELLOW PERIANTH.
9. One bloom, SMALL CUP, (DIV 3) WHITE PERIANTH.
10. Three blooms, SMALL CUP, (DIV 3).
11. One bloom, DOUBLE, (DIV 4).
12. Three blooms, DOUBLE, (DIV 4).
13. One stem, MULTI HEADED, (DIV 4).
14. Three stems MULTI HEADED, (DIV 4).
15. One stem, TRIANDRUS, (DIV 5).
16. One stem, TAZETTA, (DIV 8).
17. Three stems, TRIANDRUS OR TAZETTA. (DIV 5 OR DIV 8).
18. One stem, CYCLAMINEUS, (DIV 6).
19. Three stems, CYCLAMINEUS, (DIV 6).
20. One stem, JONQUILLA, (DIV 7).
21. Three stems, JONQUILLA, (DIV 7).
22. One bloom, SPLIT CORONA, (DIV 11).
23. Three blooms, SPLIT CORONA, (DIV 11).
24. One stem, MINIATURE*.
25. Three stems MINIATURE*.
26. One stem, INTERMEDIATE*.
27. Three stems INTERMEDIATE*.
28. One stem, ANY OTHER TYPE NOT INCLUDED IN CLASSES 1 – 27.
29. Three stems, ANY OTHER TYPE NOT INCLUDED IN CLASSES 1 – 27.
30. One stem, any variety in an 8 x 6 inch FRAME (Supplied by the Society) Only Daffodil foliage allowed, which must be contained within frame.
31. One pot, DAFFODILS, ANY VARIETY.
32. One pot, DAFFODILS, maximum size of pot eight inches, ANY VARIETY.

An exhibitor may have more than one entry in classes 31 & 32.

*Cultivars in classes 24 to 27 must be included in the Daffodil Society's relevant lists held by the Show Secretary.
