Championship Classes

Championship A.

Six blooms LARGE EXHIBITION (Section 1) and/or MEDIUM EXHIBITION (Section 2) to be shown in separate vases.

Championship B.

Two vases, five blooms in each, TWO CULTIVARS, (Section 3 and/or 4 and/or 5) a different cultivar in each vase.

Championship C.

Three vases, SINGLES, a minimum of two cultivars, five blooms in each vase.

Championship D.

Three vases comprising:

One LARGE or MEDIUM EXHIBITION plus any two vases of different form classifications from the following:

Three blooms, INCURVED or INTERMEDIATE or REFLEXED or Five blooms SINGLES. A different cultivar in each vase.

Championship E.

Three vases, LATE FLOWERING SPRAYS, three cultivars, three stems in each vase, a different cultivar in each vase OR Three vases, ANEMONES, three cultivars, five stems in each vase, a different cultivar in each vase.

Section A.

1. Three vases, each of three blooms, three cultivars section 3 and/or 4 and/or 5. A different cultivar in each vase.
2. Two vases, each of five stems, ANEMONE (Section A or B).
3. One vase, five blooms, SINGLE.
4. One vase, five blooms, LARGE, INTERMEDIATE, INCURVED or REFLEXED.
5. One vase, five blooms, MEDIUM or SMALL INCURVED.
6. ONE VASE, five blooms, MEDIUM or SMALL REFLEXED or INTERMEDIATE.
7. CASCADE or CHARM. An exhibitor may have more than one entry in this class.

12. One bloom, INCURVE, INTERMEDIATE REFLEX.
13. One bloom, SINGLE OR ANEMONE
14. One stem, SPRAY.
15. One vase, three blooms, LARGE INTERMEDIATE, INCURVED or REFLEXED.
16. One vase, three blooms, MEDIUM INCURVED.
17. One vase, three blooms MEDIUM REFLEXED or INTERMEDIATE one cultivar.
18. One vase, five blooms, MEDIUM SINGLE FLOWERED.
19. One vase, five blooms, LARGE SINGLE FLOWERED.

20. One vase, five blooms, TWO OR MORE CULTIVARS, sections 3,4 or 5.
21. One vase, five blooms of one classification, Sections 3,4,5,6,7 A or B.
22. One vase, five stems, ANEMONE SECTION 6, A or B.
23. One vase, three blooms, ANY CLASSIFICATION. May be staged in separate vases.
24. One vase, three stems, LATE FLOWERING SPRAYS.
