1. One bloom, GIANT OR LARGE DECORATIVE.
2. One bloom, GIANT OR LARGE CACTUS OR SEMI-CACTUS.
3. Three blooms, GIANT OR LARGE CACTUS &/OR SEMI- CACTUS &/OR GIANT OR LARGE DECORATIVE. May be staged in separate vases.
4. Three blooms, MEDIUM DECORATIVE.
5. Three blooms, MEDIUM CACTUS OR SEMI-CACTUS.
6. Three blooms, SMALL DECORATIVE.
7. Three blooms, SMALL CACTUS OR SEMI-CACTUS.
8. Three blooms, SMALL OR MINIATURE BALL.
9. Three blooms, MINIATURE DECORATIVE.
10. Three blooms, MINIATURE CACTUS OR SEMI-CACTUS.
11. Five blooms, POMPON or LARGE POMPON.
12. Three blooms, WATERLILY.
13. Three blooms, COLLERETTE.
14. Three blooms, ANY OTHER CLASSIFICATION NOT MENTIONED ABOVE.
15. One Dahlia bloom in a 8 x 6 inch FRAME (Supplied by the Society). Only Dahlia foliage allowed which must be contained within frame, size limits on bloom do not apply.
16. NOVICE CLASS – Three Blooms, ANY CLASSIFICATION.
